## Puppet Fun!

We had a great week exploring different types of puppets, building a theatre and making up stories. We made a stick puppet of our own.

You will need: some card of different colours, a lolly pop stick, some googly eyes, a very small piece of fur or wool, some tissue paper and a crayon.

- Cut a circle out of some card to make the dog's head.
- Cut a smaller circle out of different coloured card to make the dog's nose.
- Stick the smaller circle in the middle of the larger circle.
- On the smaller circle scrunch up some tissue and stick it in the middle for the dog's nose. Draw a mouth onto the dog and some whiskers.
- Stick on two googly eyes.
- Cut out two ear shapes and stick those onto the larger circle. Stick a little bit of fur or wool onto the ears.
- Finally use some sellotape to secure the lolly pop stick onto the back of the puppet.
