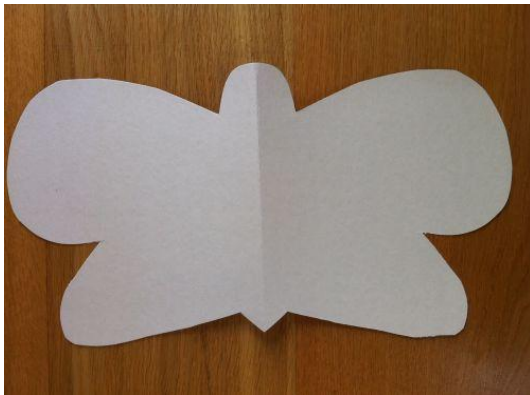

Painting Butterflies

You will need paint of different colours, paper and paintbrushes.

- Cut a butterfly shape out of the paper.
- Paint the butterfly but only on one half. You could do some spots or stripes on it.
- Now fold your butterfly over and press down all round.
- Open up your butterfly carefully and hopefully you will have a beautiful symmetrical butterfly.



Top Tips:

It is a good idea to fold your butterfly in half before you start painting so that only one side is visible to be painted on. Make sure you use quite a bit of paint so that the paint transfers easily onto the other side.
