

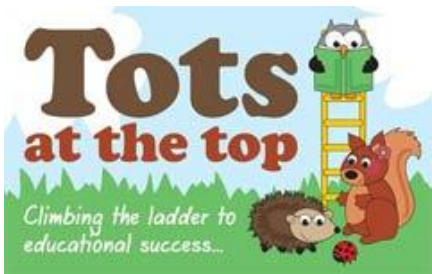


Making window candles.

You will need: black sugar paper, coloured acetate paper or tissue paper, pritt stick, scissors.

- Using the black paper, cut out a candle shape.
- Cut out the middle of the candle and the middle of the flame
- Stick strips of the acetate or tissue paper horizontally up the stem of the candle.
- Choose a yellow or orange piece of acetate to fill in the flame.
- Turn your candle over and decorate the black outline with glitter.
- Hang your candle in the window so that the light shines through the different colours.
